

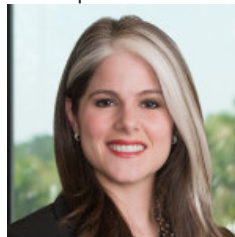
Kelley Kronenberg Adds Six New Attorneys to Miami Office

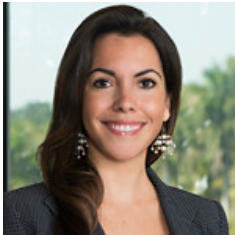
building.

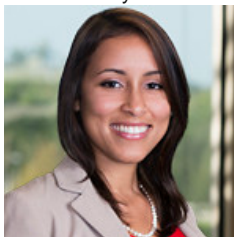
of Florida and went on to earn his law degree from Stetson University.

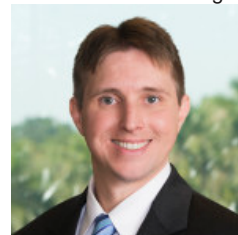
fluent in Spanish.
