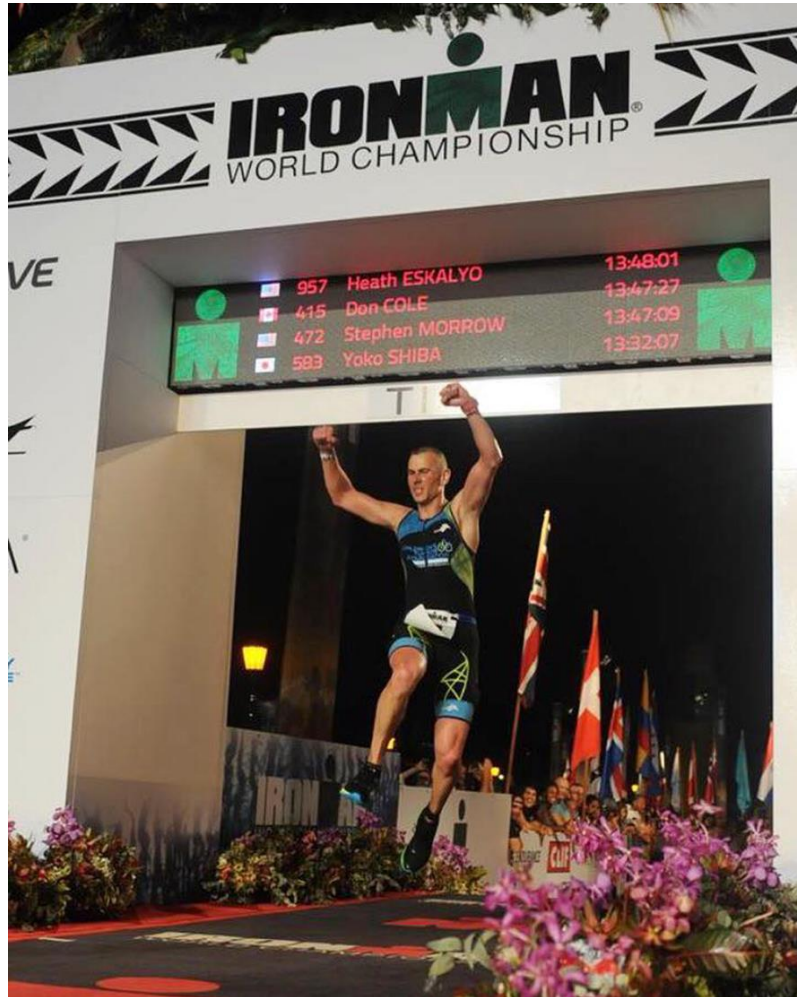

HEATH ESKALYO of Kelley Kronenberg in Ft. Lauderdale completed the 2017 Ironman World Championship in Kona, Hawaii. Eskalyo was invited to participate in the race by the Children's Tumor Foundation's NF Endurance Team, which funds research to find treatments for neurofibromatosis. Eskalyo raised \$42,076 to benefit the organization. The Ironman World Championship race consists of a 2.4-mile swim, a 112-mile bike ride, and a 26.2-mile run. Eskalyo finished the race in 13 hours, 48 minutes, and 2 seconds.
